
HOMETOWN HEROES BANNER PROGRAM

To honor our local "Hometown Heroes," we will begin the Hometown Heroes Banner Program for 2023 on February 2, 2024 and will accept applications through April 12, 2024.

- Each individual banner is unique and honors specific "Hometown Heroes" who have honorably served or is currently serving our country.
- The 30 x 60 red, white, and blue banner will include the name of the service person, their branch, and era of service, along with a military photo.
- · The banner is the same design on both sides.
- The banners will be on display in Slidell's downtown area from Memorial Day, Monday, May 27, 2024 through Veterans Day, Monday, November 11, 2024. Additional locations may be added in future years.
- The cost for each 2024 banner is \$125 plus tax. SEI Specialty Enhanced Imaging is the printer.
- Banners will be returned to you after the banners are removed from display at a ceremony to be held in early 2025.
- Banner applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis based on the timestamp of the email you return with the application.
- Once your banner is displayed, you must skip a year before applying again; at which time a new banner will need to be purchased.
- Upon approval of the application, Hero's photo and payment should be brought to SEI Specialty Enhanced Printing, 429 South Street, Slidell, LA 70460.
